The theme of our 2010 Annual Report—*A Ministry To Many...Inspiring Altruism*—chronicles the impact that Presby's Inspired Life has on the quality of life for residents in need.

Our compassionate approach toward improving the lives of those entrusting us with their care is driven by benevolent support that assists us in our quest to address the challenges they face.

We foster "Inspiring Altruism" to residents in need in our affordable housing and continuing care communities so that they may experience an enhanced quality of life that they may otherwise not have known.

In 2010—of the organization's 2,800 residents—1,986 benefited from Presby's affordable housing ministry, where the average household income was \$10,000 per year. Additionally, Presby provided more than \$3.5 million in charitable support to seniors within our residential and continuing care communities.

Such support is made possible due to the unwavering generosity of our individual, corporate, interfaith and foundation donors, as well as various charitable support funds established to assist older adults in need.

In today's challenging economic climate, many of our residents throughout our entire organization are facing concerns over meeting—or continuing to meet—the cost of their care. So that we may ease their worries and continue our mission of enabling them to live life in all its fullness, we must undergird our philanthropic support funds.

As you read through the report, you will gain insight into how our charitable support helps to serve the needs of older adults in pursuit of the most meaningful experiences that circumstances will allow. The Year in Review...

The year 2010 ushered in significant milestones for Presby's Inspired Life, as it marked the 55th anniversary of our founding. The act of ministry in 1955 by members of the Presbytery of Philadelphia to assist 14 older women in financial need created a legacy of compassion that today remains the catalyst for our continued development. This sense of compassion resonated during 2010 as Presby progressed with advancements in our capacity as a "Ministry To Many."

In January, Presby assumed ownership of Grace Court, a 101-unit affordable housing community in Yeadon, PA, from the Mercy Health System. Grace Court represents Presby's first affordable housing community in Delaware County. Formerly known as Mercy Court, Grace Court's transition, which was commemorated with two

celebratory events, occurred as Mercy Health was awarded a \$2.3 million grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for renovations to meet assisted living guidelines so that residents may continue to age gracefully with necessary care and services. Mercy Health chose Presby's Inspired Life as Grace Court's adoptive organization because of our demonstrated expertise in managing affordable housing at both the independent and enhanced care levels. Further exemplifying success in our affordable housing offerings, in May we celebrated the completion of the Riverside Presbyterian Apartments renovation initiative, providing for a more comfortable, modern environment for residents at our first affordable housing community.

Presby's repositioning plan for Rydal Park—our largest continuing care community—continued in earnest with construction progressing on the highly anticipated medical center. Residents, team members and contractors celebrated the November “topping-off” ceremony commemorating the installation of the final piece of roof steel, marking the completion of yet another phase of construction in this historic undertaking. Additional enhancements to Rydal Park included upgrades to the lobby, reception and common areas, as well as the addition of an inviting club room for residents' social enrichment.

Taking our offerings to a higher level while further solidifying our stance as a leader in service delivery, we launched our “Presby's Service from the Heart” customer service initiative. The goal of the program is to further invest in our team members so that they

may provide outstanding customer service that consistently exceeds residents' expectations.

Presby's reputation for superior service was reaffirmed once again as we received several accolades from prestigious organizations: The Board of Directors of On Lok House, our managed affordable housing community in the Chinatown section of

Philadelphia, was honored with the 2010 Distinguished Service Award for Advocacy by our state association, PANPHA; both Rosemont and Spring Mill communities were honored with "Best Of" distinctions by area newspapers; and, for the second consecutive year, Bensalem Presbyterian Apartments received the Excellence in Housing Management Award from the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency.

As we advance our offerings in our communities, we celebrated our Presbyterian heritage by launching the Honorable Service Grant Program. Established to honor Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) personnel for dedicated service, the program provides assistance toward entrance fees to Rydal Park or Rosemont Presbyterian Village for qualified candidates.

Our philanthropy efforts garnered much support with generous donors contributing to our ministry with unwavering dedication. We recorded nearly \$1 million in overall gifts, a testament that—even during challenging economic times—the commitment of our benefactors is steadfast.

The “Call To Care” Capital Campaign for the new medical center at Rydal Park continued to gain momentum, which was exemplified in May when the total raised surpassed the halfway mark toward our \$5 million goal. Additionally, our 58th Street Campus Beautification Project reached its \$120,000 goal, enabling an outdoor oasis to be completed for the enhanced quality of life for residents in our three affordable housing communities there. At Spring Mill Presbyterian Village, a similar outdoor improvement initiative was completed, made possible by charitable donations from our corporate and private benefactors.

Our Presbyterian heritage, coupled with our compassionate duty, will enable Presby’s Inspired Life to energize our mission. With a deep-rooted appreciation for our past and a strategic eye on the future, Presby will continue to evolve as a “Ministry To Many.”

“Charitable support programs at Presby’s Inspired Life are made possible by individuals, corporations, churches and foundations,” said President & CEO Judee M. Bavaria. “They provide financial assistance to residents with myriad needs, enabling them to live an enhanced quality of life that, in many cases, they may otherwise not have known.”

Presby’s Inspired Life was founded on a benevolent commitment to provide necessary care and housing for older adults, particularly those in financial need. This commitment inspired a legacy of charitable support that today touches hearts and enriches lives.

Benevolent support from individuals and organizations augments Presby’s ability to continue providing financial support to residents in need. The necessity for Presby to supplement such support continues to grow as residents’ financial and care needs progress. To that end, Presby relies on the continuous generosity of donors.

“My wife and I needed to be in a place where we would both receive necessary care when the time arrived,” attests Rosemont Presbyterian Village resident Rev. Bill Thompson. For Bill and his wife Dorcas—who moved to Rosemont in 2008—living at the Presby’s Inspired Life community has added to their sense of security and community.

“There is a true sense of compassion and family here,” says Dorcas. “It has enhanced our vision of retirement living by providing opportunities for social enrichment, medical care, spiritual fulfillment and friendships.”

As retired school teachers—and Bill a retired Presbyterian pastor—one of their favorite activities is serving as editors of the Rosemont Presbyterian Village newsletter, “The Voice.” The Thompsons represent a growing number of seniors receiving financial support to sustain their care and support.

One of the aspects that makes Presby’s Inspired Life unique is that it serves older adults of all income levels. For those seniors of moderate income, like Bill and Dorcas, they fall into the “gap group,” those of middle income who are not eligible for government assistance, but who are unable to meet the full cost of care on their own. Presby’s charitable support programs enable them to sustain their high quality of life living at Presby residential and continuing care communities.

Carrying on its charitable legacy each year, Presby’s Inspired Life continues to provide assistance to residents in need ministry-wide.

Throughout Presby’s continuing care communities, more than \$2.4 million in direct financial assistance was provided in 2010 through various funds such as the Bala Foundation, as well as the Gibbons and Schaeffer-Schell Funds. Each charitable support program assists residents with meeting monthly fees. Additionally, programs such as the Compassionate Care Program and the Friendship Fund help residents by helping to provide quality programming, vital equipment and personal items, as well as health and wellness initiatives. In addition to these programs, Presby also launched its Honorable Service Grant Program in 2010 to honor Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) personnel for dedicated service. The Program provides assistance with entrance fees to a Presby’s Inspired Life continuing care community equal to 10 percent off entrance fees up to \$10,000.

In keeping with the original act of charity more than 55 years ago, it is the goal of Presby’s Inspired Life to continue to perpetuate its charitable support, alleviating anxiety and concerns among residents and creating opportunities for them to live life in all its fullness.

“We wouldn’t be living here had it not been for support from Presby’s Inspired Life,” added Bill. “I sense that it was God’s will.”

“Living in Presby’s Affordable Housing gives me a sense of comfort and community,” said Riverside Presbyterian Apartments resident Alma Graves. “As someone on a fixed income, I no longer have to worry about household expenses, and I get to be among friends.”

One of Alma’s friends is Joanne Lee. The two ladies had been neighbors for more than forty years, having raised their families in the same Southwest Philadelphia neighborhood, until Joanne moved into Riverside in 1999.

“I told Alma that she should move to Riverside, too,” Joanne said. “Living here enables you to have a fulfilling life that’s affordable, without the stress of being alone all the time and taking care of a house.”

Alma heeded her friend’s advice and moved to Riverside in 2007. The two once again enjoy spending time together, especially shopping online in the building’s Neighborhood Networks Computer Learning Center, a HUD-sponsored program designed to promote self-sufficiency and contact with the broader community.

Alma and Joanne represent an upward trend in the number of seniors of low income in the Philadelphia area who are living longer and benefitting from affordable housing. **In fact, according to the United States Census Bureau, of Philadelphia’s approximate 1.5 million residents, 217,000 are over the age of 65; of that group, 39,000 are below the poverty level.** For them, affordable housing represents a vital solution.

So that seniors of low income may enjoy an enhanced quality of life, Presby’s Inspired Life began its Affordable Housing ministry in 1981 with the opening of Riverside Presbyterian Apartments in the heart of Center City, Philadelphia. Since then, Presby’s Affordable Housing complement has grown to include 24 sponsored and managed sites throughout the Greater Philadelphia area, in partnership with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

“The affordable housing stock in the Philadelphia area is relatively low compared to the demand,” added Presby’s Vice President of Affordable Housing Jim Polaski. “In fact, the waiting period for a Presby apartment can be up to five years.” To meet this growing demand, Presby strives to further advance its mission for low-income seniors in need for affordable housing. To that end, new sponsorship opportunities are continuously explored.

“The process includes identifying land, designing the apartment building, and then applying to HUD for development grants or to the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency for tax credit offerings,” added Jim. “The beginning phase of the process, which can take up to one year or longer, can be quite costly to Presby.”

Before an application can be submitted to HUD to potentially build a new apartment community, Presby must invest a great deal of capital for “start-up” costs.

Some of the myriad components in the development of an affordable housing community include legal and architectural services, marketing initiatives, as well as environmental and geological feasibility studies. This “start-up” phase can far exceed \$75,000 in development costs that are not reimbursed.

As Presby's Inspired Life continues to build possibilities for low-income seniors, it seeks additional support to supplement “start-up” costs. Support from generous individual and corporate benefactors can make a tremendous impact on the continuation of Presby's Affordable Housing ministry and on the quality of life for seniors in need.

The goal of Presby's Affordable Housing is to foster safe, quality experiences that residents may otherwise not have known; however, its impact can't be measured on a financial flowchart or in an architect's rendering, but in the feelings of those it serves.

“What is most reassuring about living in affordable housing is that my sense of community isn't interrupted,” added Alma. “There are always activities to enjoy and friends with whom to enjoy them.”

“Having the food program available makes me feel more independent,” attests Ann Thomas Presbyterian Apartments resident Gladys Johnson. “I don’t have to prepare meals myself, which affords me time to enjoy my friends and neighbors.”

Gladys, who uses a wheelchair as a result of a stroke, is one of nearly 250 residents who live in one of the Presby’s Inspired Life Affordable Housing apartment units on The 58th Street Campus. This vibrant community of seniors features the Ann Thomas, Mary Field and Greenway Presbyterian

Apartments. Nearly 100 percent of residents move to the Campus from the surrounding Southwest Philadelphia neighborhood. For them, staying close to familiar surroundings and family adds to their sense of security and peace of mind, as well as their sense of community. What’s more is that the apartments also meet a critical need for affordability. They are U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Section 202 developments for seniors of limited income.

“Living in Presby’s Affordable Housing has taken the worry off of my shoulders,” said resident Charlotte Young. “I don’t have to take care of a house any more or worry about paying a high rent.”

To better meet the evolving needs of residents on the Campus so that they may age in place with necessary support and services, Presby’s Inspired Life partnered with HUD in 2002 through the Assisted Living Conversion Grant Program to convert 28 units in the Ann Thomas building into supportive living apartments, providing additional amenities and services for assistance when needed.

In 2010, Presby expanded the scope of services at the Campus to include a food program for residents living in the supportive living accommodations.

“The food program meets a critical need for residents living on The 58th Street Campus,” said Senior Housing Manager Ruth James. “By serving the meals dining room style in the community room, it provides socialization benefits, daily proper nutrition, as well as respite for caregivers.”

A nutritious, well-balanced meal is available for an average of \$6.00 per day, per resident. Since

there is no government funding available to subsidize the program, residents—whose average annual income is \$10,000 (less rent)—must bear the cost themselves, making the food program cost-prohibitive in many cases.

In addition to the Ann Thomas building, a food program is also available at Grace Court, Presby’s Affordable Housing community in Delaware County that also offers supportive living accommodations. As a ministry, Presby’s Inspired Life continuously strives to advance its affordable housing services for residents. The benefits of the food program are truly bountiful, and the need to subsidize and expand it is integral to residents’ improved well-being. For them, the many fruits of the program lie in the proverbial pudding.

“It’s true that meals provide us with convenience, affordability and nutrition, but we also enjoy the fellowship among friends,” added Charlotte, “Meals always taste better when shared together as a community; the food program is also about companionship.”

Inspiring Leadership

Since its founding in 1955, Presby's Inspired Life has created a legacy of philanthropy throughout our continuing care and affordable housing communities by serving a diverse population of seniors of all faiths, ethnicities and economic circumstances. This legacy makes a profound impact on residents' quality of life by providing assistance for those in need to enjoy the retirement that they may never have thought possible.

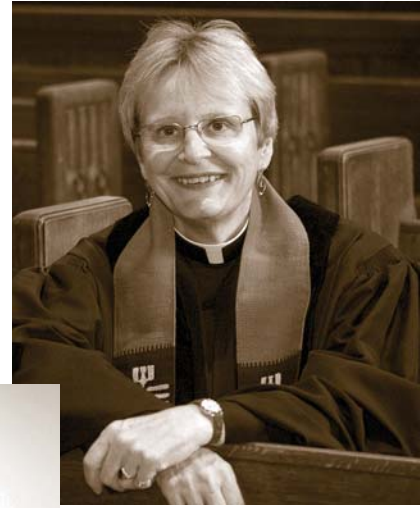

Robert is also chair of Presby's Philanthropy Advisory Council, a strategic driving force of volunteers who enhance Presby's mission. Through outreach, advocacy and philanthropy, the Council builds the capacity of Presby's Inspired Life to assist the neediest and most vulnerable individuals with financial assistance; offer residential experiences that foster quality, independence and dignity; and uphold benevolence in the provision of care and services through the entire ministry.

"I've witnessed first-hand the noble mission of Presby's Inspired Life," said Philanthropy Advisory Committee member and Presby Board member Julie Pfaff. "This mission in action is why I feel Presby is an organization worthy of my commitment and much-needed charitable support."

In many instances, seniors are finding that the retirement they planned and hoped for is in jeopardy due to volatile economic conditions, creating the possibility of them outliving their assets. Additionally, government reimbursements and other subsidies do not cover the full cost of elder care, creating a greater need for charitable support.

"Philanthropy has a tremendous impact in making many possibilities a reality for residents," added President & CEO Judee M. Bavaria. "The need to attract generous support is continuous for those we serve. To further advance our ministerial role, the

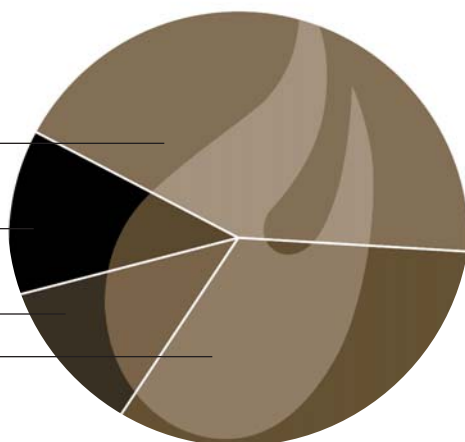

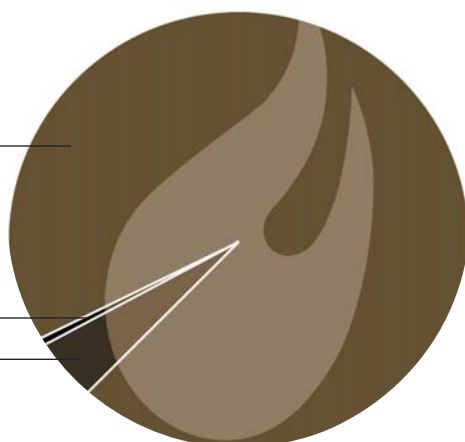

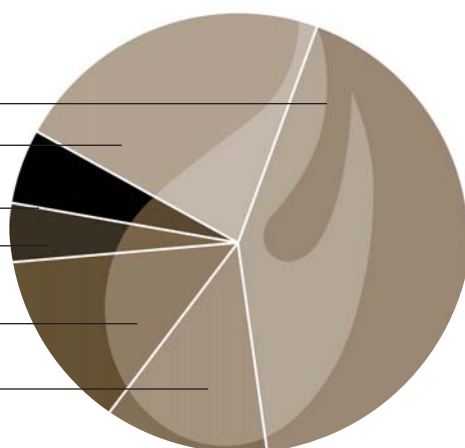
